Quarry Park Masterplan Update

Council is continuing to implement the Quarry Park Masterplan, with the installation of bike trails in early 2019.

The trails consist of:

- A gentle ascending trail
- Descending trails at beginner and intermediate levels
- A skills park incorporating learn-to-ride elements and technical features
- An asphalt pump track located to the south of the existing cricket nets
- Extensive landscaping and tree planting between trails
- A picnic area, seating and drinking fountains.

Construction of the trails is anticipated to be complete by May 2019.

This project is a partnership with the Victorian Government through a Community Sports Infrastructure Grant.




