What is Creative West?

It will include a large scale performance venue, a library, learning and innovation hub, open space and spaces for the arts and community groups and gatherings. It will provide the community, artists, creatives access to the latest technology for learning, artistic and cultural pursuits, as well as being a vibrant centralised activation space for Footscray Priority Precinct that will stimulate and drive economic, employment and business outcomes well into the future. Creative West will position itself as the premier gateway venue to the west.

Investment opportunity

This \$154 million joint investment between local, state and federal government will support greater economic development, employment opportunities and urban renewal and support local small businesses in Melbourne's west. Council is ready to contribute substantially to this project including funding, land and civic services.
