

Proposal for 50 km/h on Churchill Ave for DoT consideration.

Upgrade roundabout to wombat crossing with bicycle/pedestrian priority (subject to DoT approval).

Investigate feasibility of painted island and pavement arrows at Churchill Ave median gaps.

Investigate pedestrian operated signal near Vine St (Working with DoT).

Upgrade roundabout to wombat crossing with bicycle/pedestrian priority (subject to DoT approval).

Proposal for 40km/h on Duke St south of Churchill Ave for DoT consideration.

Proposed bicycle route on Darnley St between South Rd and Churchill Ave.

Proposal for 50 km/h on South Rd for DoT consideration.

Investigate future safety improvement works (post Orion housing development).

Reshape the kerb outstands at Crick St and install bicycle lane line marking.

Undertake a separate study to improve safety at the area.

Advocate to DoT to:

- Improve pedestrian safety on Ashley St between Churchill Ave and South Rd.
- Proposed on road bike lane on Ashley St between Churchill Ave and Marsden Pde.

Proposed bicycle route on Melon St.

Future bicycle lane improvements on South Rd between Ashley St and Darnley Rd.

Investigate potential road closure of Melon St/South Rd intersection as part of future projects identified in Bicycle Strategy 2020-30.

Install pedestrian operated signal (Working with DoT).

Incorporate flat top speed hump at the bike path.

Install give way sign and line marking Improve pedestrian safety.

Install raised platform at existing pedestrian operated signal (subject to DoT approval and speed limit reduction to 50km/h).

Raised platform at bend.

Investigate improving bike lanes on Teague Crescent.

Install speed limit pavement marking on all road surfaces.
