The application is for a permit to:	Extension of a residential building, and buildings and works including a ground and first-floor extension and partial demolition within a Heritage Overlay

Description of the Proposal: <div style="text-align: center;">  View Advertised Plans </div>	The proposal is briefly summarised as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Construction of a ground and first-floor addition to the rear of the building to enable its use as a rooming house; • Upper-level extension to be contained below ridgeline of existing building, with ground-floor extension constructed boundary-to-boundary towards the rear; • Extension constructed of render with weatherboard detailing at rear and corrugated roof sheeting; • Maximum building height of 5.86m; • Two car parking spaces to be located in front of the building and accessed via a reconstructed driveway; • Works and partial demolition to existing building including front window replacement and replacement of roof tiles with corrugated sheeting.

An objection must be sent to the Responsible Authority in writing and include the reasons for the objection and state how the objector would be affected. If you object, the responsible authority will tell you of its decision.

Lodge Objection

The responsible authority must make a copy of every objection available for any person to inspect free of charge until the end of the period during which an application may be made for review of a decision on the application.

The Responsible Authority will not decide on the application before:	27th September 2024
