



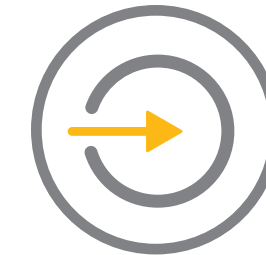
### Introduction
